

Soul Art in South Africa Feb/March 2010

Tatiana Binovskaya invites you to join the artistic pilgrimage exploring South African Province of Western Cape. The group of artists, photographers and creators alike will travel for 12 days amongst the fishing villages of both Eastern and Western coasts. The event will end with a spectacular Soul Art action painting in Cape Town, followed by the opening of the exhibition.

ITINERARY

26 Feb ~ Journey starts from Cape Town International Airport. Participants meet with Tatyana and proceed to the first night accommodation in the famous region of **Cape Winelands**. The welcome dinner and wine tasting provided on this day.

27 Feb ~ Depart to **Hermanus**, the former fishing village on the Eastern Coast of the Cape Province. Specialists claim that the mountains of this region contain a very high amount of spiritual energy, while normal person would just notice an amazingly relaxing atmosphere of this cute coastal town. Accommodation Hermanus for two nights.

28 Feb ~ Journey to Cape Agulhas – the Southern most tip of African continent.

1 March ~ Today the pilgrimage will take you back inland, to explore the magnificent **Big Five**. At Aquilla Game Reserve you'll see Elephant, Lion, Rhino, Leopard and Buffalo. The night at African Game Lodge.

2 March ~ Morning safari at **African Game Lodge**. Then lunch, and depart further West.

For the next two nights we settle in a village of **Paternoster**. Local beaches are the closest to the image created by Alessandro Baricco in his «Oceano-Mare». This part of the trip should bring us all together in understanding of the greatness of the God's creation.

3 March ~ This day we relax and meditate in Paternoster. You can also visit a nearby West Coast National Park.

4 March ~ Depart for Cape Town. Arrive to a large house with many bedrooms – able to accommodate all the participants. The Cape Town welcome dinner will be a traditional South African Braai (barbeque).

5 March ~ Travel to the most South Western tip of Africa – **The Cape of Good Hope**. The full day trip includes visit to seal island, penguins colony and Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve. You'll see both sides of Cape Peninsula – the Atlantic and False Bay Coasts.

6 March ~ In the morning we suggest the visit to the **Old Bisquit Mill**.

7 March ~ **Soul Art action painting in the port of Cape Town.**

8 March ~ Relax and explore Cape Town. Additional excursions and entertainment suggested.

9 March ~ 18:00 exhibition opening.

10 March ~ Depart Home.
